| *Garlic | Japanese Beetles |
| *Horseradish | Potato Bugs |
| *Geraniums | Japanese Beetles |
| *Hyssop | Cabbage Moths |
| *Lavender | Clothes Moths |
| *Marigold | Mexican bean beetles, nematodes |
| *Mint | White Cabbage moths |
| *Nasturtium | Aphids, squash bugs, whitefly |
| *Pennyroyal | Ants, Lice |
| *Peppermint | White Cabbage butterfly Ants |
| *Petunia | Beetles |
| *Rosemary | Cabbage Moths, Bean Beetles, Carrot flies Mosquitoes |
| *Rue | Japanese Beetles |
| *Sage | Cabbage Moths, Carrot Flies, Ticks |
| *Spearmint | Ants, Aphids |
| *Summer Savory | Bean Beetles |
| *Thyme | Cabbage Worm |
