# “Onion” (*Allium cepa*)

Planting depth: ½”    Apart in row (after thinning): ½”-1”    Distance between rows: 12”-18”    Approximate days to germination: 7-12days

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## ♥ Let's grow...

Bunching onion seeds are very small. They should be sprinkled in rows over the ground and covered with a small amount of soil about ½” deep. Onions grow best when planted in a sunny area where the soil has been dug deeply and does not have stones or weeds. It takes about 7-12 days for the seeds to sprout into seedlings. Seedlings are new plants grown from seeds.

## ♥ Taking care of God's creation...

It is important that onion seedlings have even watering. Thin to ½”-1” apart in a row so that they have enough room to grow. Onions are ready to pick when the stem is about 6” tall or the tops turn yellow or bend.

## ♥ Eat your onions...

Also known as green onions, they were first grown in Asia nearly 5,000 years ago. Onions are a good source of vitamins for healthy bodies. You can show God's love to others by sharing the good food that he has given us to eat.
