# “Onions” (*Allium cepa*)

Planting depth: ½”    Apart in row (after thinning): 2”-4”    Distance between rows: 18”-24”    Approximate days to germination: 7-12 days

---

Let's grow...

♥ Plant onion seeds ½” deep in a sunny area of your garden where the soil has been dug deeply and does not have stones or weeds. It takes about 7-12 days for the seeds to sprout into seedlings. Seedlings are new plants grown from seeds.

♥ Taking care of God's creation...

New onion plants need regular watering and weeding to grow. Thin them to 2”-4” apart. The onion is done growing when the green stem falls over. Pull gently on the stem to remove the onion from the soil.

♥ Eat your onions...

First grown in Asia nearly 5,000 years ago, onions are a good source of vitamins for healthy bodies. You can show God's love to others by sharing the good food that he has given us to eat.
