

God gave us...



“Turnip” (Brassica rapa)

Planting depth: ¼”-1/2” Apart in row (after thinning) : 3”-4” Distance between rows: 12”-24” Approximate days until germination: 5-10 days

♥ Let's grow...

Plant seeds ¼”-1/2” deep in a sunny area of your garden. Turnips grow best where the soil has been deeply dug and is free of weeds and stones. It takes about 5-10 days for the seeds to sprout into seedlings. Seedlings are new plants grown from seeds.

♥ Taking care of God's creation...

New plants need regular watering and weeding. Thin seedlings to 3”-4” apart. Turnips are ready to eat when the root is about 3”-4” across. The green leaves can also be eaten while tender when they reach 4”-6” tall.

♥ Eat your turnips...

Turnips are good source of vitamins needed for healthy bodies. You can show God's love to others by sharing the good food he has given us to eat.
